Licensing Modes

EMCO products are available in different licensing modes which gives user the flexibility to choose the product according to their needs.

The following three modes for licensing are available for EMCO Products (depending on the products):

- ▣ **Site License** - Site License is for companies that have multiple sites. If your Enterprise has different departments located in different buildings, having their separate networks and you need the selected products for all nodes on all departments, then EMCOSite license is for you. It gives you the flexibility to manage your networks in all departments with unlimited number of nodes
- ▣ **Enterprise License** - Enterprise license provides enterprises level flexibility to you. If your Enterprise is spread over different cities, having different offices nationwide or internationally, then Enterprise License would be a best choice for you. It gives you the flexibility to manage your networks in all offices with unlimited number of nodes.
- ▣ **Node Level License** - This mode is best suited for companies who want to have licenses on the bases of their use i.e. the number of computer they have on their network. EMCO provides the following nodes level licensing for products:
 - ◆ **For 50 nodes** - This is for companies having small networks with maximum of 50 nodes on their network.
 - ◆ **For 100 nodes** - This license options is for companies having maximum of 100 nodes on their network.
 - ◆ **For 200 nodes** - This option is for companies having maximum of 200 nodes on their network.
 - ◆ **For 500 nodes** - This option is for companies having maximum of 500 nodes on their network.
 - ◆ **For 1000 nodes** - This option is for companies having maximum of 1000 nodes son their network.
 - ◆ **For 2000 nodes** - This option is for companies having maximum of 2000 nodes son their network.
 - ◆ **For 5000 nodes** - This option is for companies having maximum of 5000 nodes son their network.
 - ◆ **For unlimited nodes** - This option gives the companies flexibility to have unlimited number of nodes on their network.
